...as long as you plant the right flowers, like butterfly bush, butterfly weed, gerbera daisies and your choice of one of the new, fancy coneflowers.



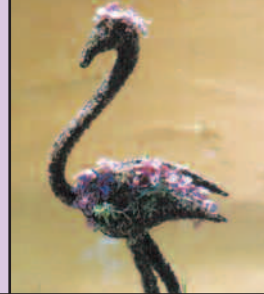
June 8
